S/He will report directly to the SRH Technical Advisor and will provide technical advice at the Sub-regional level in the area of HIV and AIDS. The Officer will work in an integrated manner with other technical and programme staff in the Sub-Regional Office in Jamaica, with the UNFPA Liaison Officers in the Liaison Offices of Barbados, Belize, Guyana, Suriname and Trinidad & Tobago and with the technical advisors in the UNFPA Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean

### **Job Purpose**

The HIV and AIDS Officer provides strategic technical and programmatic leadership in the area of Integrated SRH/HIV programming.

The Incumbent will foster partnerships and establish/strengthen advocacy platforms with regional stakeholders including with regional entities, CSOs, United Nations entities, academia and the private sector. S/He will formulate and promote fundraising and partnership proposals that will allow the SRO to address funding gaps and assist in upholding of human rights-based approaches in securing SRH rights and ensuring universal access to SRH including family planning, HIV prevention and sexual violence prevention, with particular focus on the most vulnerable population (adolescents, LGBTQI, migrants and other groups).

### **Work Relations**

External partners include UN agencies and programme countries; Sub-regional and international organizations and counterparts on substantive issues including, Government organizations, NGOs, community-based organizations and peer-organizations of vulnerable communities, academia, and research institutions, professional associations, and international experts; Donor institutions including the private sector; in developing a wider network of technical experts and institutions in the region to provide technical support to countries.
