- Participates in the development of procedures to ensure the collection of disaggregated data, quality control, analysis and dissemination of results.

- Supports countries and regional initiatives in undertaking demographic analysis of censuses and household surveys, by preparing reports on the levels and trends of ICPD-related indicators, and by elaborating population projections.
