Purpose of Consultancy

To assess the capacity of community-led organizations (CLOs) to respond to cases of sexual violence against marginalized populations in Jamaica and offer capacity building to improve the CLOs capacity addressing the identified gaps

Background

The **Spotlight Initiative** (SI) aims at mobilizing the commitment of political leaders and contributing to achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The Spotlight Initiative will deploy targeted, large-scale investments in Asia, Africa, Latin America, the Pacific and the Caribbean, aimed at achieving significant improvements in the lives of women and girls. Jamaica is one of the countries in the Caribbean to benefit from this transformative initiative

Scope of work

1. Assessment report with a systematization of the information collected and triangulated about the capacity of the community-led organizations to respond to the cases of sexual violence against the marginalized populations cited above.
2. A workshop for each of the four targeted parishes to address the recommendations of the assessment and develop action plans
