Hiring Office:	Sub-Regional Office for the Caribbean (SROC)			
Purpose of consultancy:	The main purpose of the consultancy is to provide graphic design and content layout services for the ESP Lessons Learned Report and the ESP Toolkit/Resource Package produced by UNFPA SROC.			
Scope of work:	Organisational Context			
(Description of context, services, activities, or outputs)	Gender-Based Violence (GBV), in particular Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG), is one of the most widespread, persistent and devastating human rights violations. It is estimated that globally, one in three women and girls have experienced some form of GBV in their lives. GBV is a public health issue that has taken pandemic proportions, and it tends to dramatically increase during periods of instability as well as humanitarian emergencies.			
	In the Caribbean, particularly, "domestic and family violence is a complex concept as violence might take place in formal and informal settings, as well as in intimate relationships within different households. Family relationships may involve previous and current partners or siblings and half-siblings who do not live in the same household. Women and girls living with disabilities, Sex workers, migrants/refugees, indigenous communities and individuals identifying as LGBTQI, are increasingly at risk of experiencing GBV, and are often indirectly excluded from lifesaving service provision, leaving them even more vulnerable and unprotected. It is not possible to calculate or estimate the prevalence or incidence rates of GBV, because there are extreme levels of under-reporting, and reporting systems tend to focus only on verified incidents of sexual violence mainly, which would be an under-representation of the variety of forms in which survivors experience violence.			
	The United Nations Joint Global Programme on Essential Services (ESP) for Women and Girls Subject to Violence, exists to support the provision of and greater access to a coordinated set of essential and quality multi-sectoral services for all women and girls who have experienced GBV.			
	UNFPA and the CARICOM Secretariat have operationalised the Caribbean Essential Services Package Community of Practice (ESP CoP) in early 2022, under the Regional Spotlight Initiative Programme. This is the first regional coordination mechanism to promote greater cooperation among key regional institutions representing the four pillars of the ESP, national gender machineries and fund-recipient agencies of the United Nations. The regional CoP provides a space for representatives of the health, social services, justice, police and education sectors, as well as the gender desk of CARICOM to support the implementation and coordination of the ESP in the Caribbean region.			

	In 2023, UNFPA is finalising its ESP lessons learned report for the Caribbean region and a standard toolkit/resource package available at the regional level, to support the planning and implementation of the ESP at the national levels, including technical assistance throughout the process. The toolkit provides a harmonised set of guidance notes and resources mapped from across the regions (documents, project management templates and powerpoints) that can support countries in the Caribbean in the ESP implementation. The ESP Lessons Learned Report and ESP Toolkit/Resource Package requires standardised and user-friendly design and layout before it can be published and launched in the ESP Community of Practice in 2023. Tasks for Consultant: The main task of the graphic designer will be to develop layout and design for the ESP Lessons Learned Report and ESP Toolkit/Resource Package, presenting information in such a way that external audiences can easily understand, read and draw lessons from the documents. Furthermore, the graphic designer will make the documents visually appealing, digestible as much as possible with the text segmented through different creative methods using (info)graphics, illustrations and pictorials where relevant.
